

**Fayette County Board Minutes**  
**Tuesday, June 13, 2023**

**Convene**

Jacob Harris, Chairperson, called the County Board of Fayette County and State of Illinois regular session meeting to order at the Fayette County Courthouse, Courtroom A 221 S 7th Street, Vandalia, Illinois, on June 13, 2023, at 7:03 p.m.

**Public Comment**

Kevin Kern, (SRM) Snedeker Risk Management told the board that they have completed the audit and it was okay. He has a quarterly Department Head meeting in the works.

Dr. Jennifer Garrison presented the board with concerns about the current OKAW Building. The building is outdated being constructed in the 1960's and can only hold 250 students. They are running out of room and need to modernize. OKAW is having to turn students away. Junior and Senior high school students are the ages for who can be in OKAW. Students have two options after graduating, either the workforce or college. Colleges like Lakeland and Kaskaskia are local and support the OKAW program. Jennifer Garrison has worked in schools for 25 years plus and has embraced that not everyone is going to college. This makes programs like OKAW a high demand and Vandalia is a good location. As of right now 13 local high schools participate in OKAW. Patrick Click commented, "Our kids future success starts here. Manufacturers are reaching out to students who were in OKAW type programs. The community needs to help the younger generation." Vandalia Mayor, Ricky Gottman presented the board with a survey of 120 acres the city owns. He would like to separate it for development. Ricky mentioned that there would be 60,000 square feet for expansion for OKAW alone. The only other program like this in Illinois is downstate in Collinsville. Kevin Satterthwaite described the structural issue with the current OKAW building. The current building is 40,000 square feet and the ceiling is too low for new equipment to be installed inside. The 60,000 square feet new building will have high ceilings and can add Junior High-level classes. This can introduce kids to a job path at a younger age, to give them a better opportunity than later after high school.
