

Fayette County Resolution 2024-08-13-B

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF COUNTY-OWNED GENERATOR
THROUGH SEALED BID

WHEREAS, Fayette County has recently purchased a new generator to meet its operational needs; and

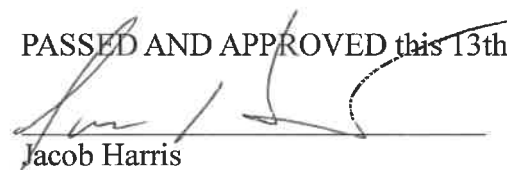
WHEREAS, the existing generator is no longer required for county operations; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Fayette County to sell the existing generator through a sealed bid process to ensure transparency and obtain the best possible price;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Fayette County, Illinois, as follows:

1. Authorization to Sell: The Fayette County Sheriff is hereby authorized to sell the county-owned generator through a sealed bid process.
2. Notice of Sale: The Sheriff shall provide public notice of the sale, including the specifications of the generator, the terms of the sale, and the deadline for submitting sealed bids. The notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within Fayette County and posted on the county's official website.
3. Sealed Bids: All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked "Generator Bid," and delivered to the Sheriff's Office by the specified deadline.
4. Bid Opening: The sealed bids shall be opened at a public meeting of the County Board, and the generator shall be sold to the highest responsible bidder, provided that the bid meets or exceeds the minimum acceptable price as determined by the County Board.
5. Right to Reject Bids: The County Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids if it determines that it is in the best interest of the county to do so.
6. Effective Date: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

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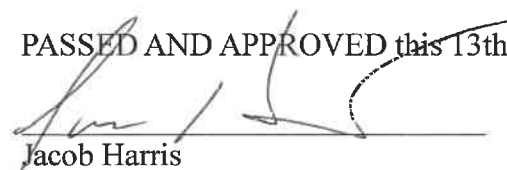
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
