- 7) County RBI project on the Kaskaskia River, Section 23-00130-01-MS
- 8) County RBI project on Ramsey Creek, Section 23-00130-02-MS
- 9) Loudon Township RBI project, Section 22-08127-00-DR
- 10) Sefton Township RBI project, Section 22-13135-00-DR
- 11) Ramsey East Resurfacing, Section 22-00132-00-RS

### **Old Business**

- 1) Shobonier Road along the Kaskaskia River: the Corps of Engineers recommends that we do not relocate the road due to concerns about wetland mitigation. They would rather we extend the existing riprap along the river to protect the road.
- 2) St. Elmo Truck Stop: a representative of the city has reached out to me and Board Member, Patrick Click. The Committee agrees that a discussion is necessary and is awaiting a more formal gesture from the city.
- 3) Thrill Hill Road drainage: nothing has changed since the meeting with the City of Vandalia.

I told members to expect new engineering agreements for future projects.


