

Ordinance of the County Board Of Fayette County, Illinois

WHEREAS, the Fayette County Board has determined the amount of money estimated and deemed necessary to meet and defray the legal liabilities and necessary expenses anticipated to be incurred from December 1, 2024, through November 30, 2025, and has adopted a detailed general fund budget and special fund budgets itemizing expenditures for said fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Fayette County Board previously adopted the Budget Appropriations and Tax Levy Ordinance for the fiscal year ending November 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of said ordinance, the County, in the normal course of business, has identified required clerical corrections and necessary budget realignments; and

WHEREAS, the County Board finds it appropriate and necessary to amend the previously adopted Budget Appropriations to reflect these updates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fayette County Board that the following amendments to the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Appropriations are hereby adopted and shall be in effect for the fiscal year ending November 30, 2025.

FAYETTE COUNTY PUBLIC SPEAKING

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Illinois Open Meetings Act (OMA) (5 ILCS 120/1) provides the people of the State of Illinois with the right to be informed as to the conduct of public business, and

WHEREAS, 5 ILCS 120/206(g) further defines the public's right to address public officials, "*Any person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body*", and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Attorney General has offered an opinion, and case precedence exist, that the method and limits placed on the public's right to address the public body shall be reasonable and made known, and

WHEREAS, the Fayette County Board of the County of Fayette are committed to compliance with the Illinois Open Meetings Act and the people's right to address the public meeting as the follow may allow.

NOW THEREFORE, the Fayette County Board hereby ordains the following:

1. A sign-up sheet shall be provided to allow members of the public to petition to speak before the Fayette County Board. Thereby allowing the Chairman to call upon members of the public in the order on the signup sheet. Members of the public who did not sign up may still be heard after all who signed up have spoken, and
2. A limit of five (5) minutes shall be placed on each member of the public who wishes to address the Fayette County Board, and
3. A speaker may not use abusive language (profanity) or convey threats or any other conduct that would distract from good order and disrupt the public meeting. The Fayette County Board Chairman may call upon the Fayette County Sheriff to restore good order, and
4. The public's right to address the board provides an opportunity to voice concerns or make recommendations. The Fayette County Board shall not engage the speaker other than to ask clarifying questions.

5. The public's right to address the Fayette County Board shall be preserved and received without comment, rebuttal, remarks or challenge from any member of the Fayette County Board save the Chairman who may call for good order, and
6. Members of the public may also submit a written statement to accompany or in lieu of public comment. A copy of such a statement shall be made a part of the public meeting record.

FURTHER, nothing contain herein shall restrict the Fayette County Board Chairman from calling upon members of the public to provide information at any time during the public meeting for the furtherance of board's duties.
