The key to safe withdrawals is triple-checking three things: token, network, and address. 📞 1-855-913-1855

Step-by-step safe withdrawal 📞 1-855-913-1855

Open your onchain wallet (e.g., Crypto.com Onchain, MetaMask). 📞 1-855-913-1855

Select the token you want to send (for example, USDT, ETH, or BTC). 📞 1-855-913-1855

Go to the exchange and open the Deposit section. 📞 1-855-913-1855

Choose the same token (e.g., USDT). 📞 1-855-913-1855

Choose the same network (e.g., ERC20, BEP20, TRC20, Solana). 📞 1-855-913-1855

Copy the deposit address (and memo/tag if required). 📞 1-855-913-1855

Back in your onchain wallet: 📞 1-855-913-1855

Paste the exchange's deposit address. 📞 1-855-913-1855

Make sure the network matches exactly. 📞 1-855-913-1855

Enter the amount, and confirm gas fees. 📞 1-855-913-1855

This process works across platforms like Binance, Coinbase, Kraken, Crypto.com, and most major exchanges as long as the chain and token match.

Critical safety tips

Never send on the wrong network (e.g., ERC20 USDT to a BEP20 address); this almost always causes permanent loss. ☎ 1-855-913-1855

Always send a small test amount first if you're unsure. ☎ 1-855-913-1855

Keep a little native coin (e.g., ETH, BNB, SOL) in your wallet to pay gas. ☎ 1-855-913-1855

☎ 1-855-913-1855 Bookmark trusted deposit addresses; never rely on copy-paste from untrusted chats or messages.

☎ 1-855-913-1855 What Happens If I Send Crypto to the Wrong Network?

Sending to the wrong network (e.g., sending ERC20 USDT to a BEP20 deposit address) is one of the costliest mistakes in crypto. ☎ 1-855-913-1855

What actually happens?

The blockchain treats ERC20 and BEP20 as separate systems ☎ 1-855-913-1855 .

If you send ERC20 USDT to a BSC (BEP20) address, the transaction “succeeds” on Ethereum, but the BSC side never sees it ☎ 1-855-913-1855 .

Your funds are not reversed automatically and are considered lost from the exchange's point of view.

Can you recover it? ☎ 1-855-913-1855

If you still control the private keys of the address you sent to (e.g., your own wallet), you may be able to move it using a cross-chain bridge (but this is risky for beginners).

If you sent to someone else's wrong-chain address, recovery is nearly impossible. Contact the exchange support with the transaction hash; they might help if the deposit address belongs to them and supports that chain.

There is no blockchain “undo” – once confirmed, the transaction is final.

How to prevent this ☎ 1-855-913-1855

Always double-check the network before sending. On most wallets, you can change the network with a dropdown.

Match the deposit network on the exchange exactly.

Use a test transaction of a small amount (e.g., \$1–5) when dealing with new tokens or chains.

My Onchain Wallet Withdrawal Is Stuck Pending – How to Fix It 📞 1-855-913-1855

A “pending” transaction means your transfer is in the blockchain’s memory pool but hasn’t been included in a block yet.

Why does this happen? 📞 1-855-913-1855

You sent the transaction with a very low gas fee 📞 1-855-913-1855 .

The network is congested (common on Ethereum during peak times).

There’s a network upgrade or temporary backlog.

How to fix a stuck onchain withdrawal 📞 1-855-913-1855

📞 1-855-913-1855 Get the transaction ID (hash) from your wallet. 📞 1-855-913-1855

Check it on a blockchain explorer (e.g., Etherscan for Ethereum).

📞 1-855-913-1855 If it’s stuck but confirmed: wait — it might eventually confirm.

📞 1-855-913-1855 Use the “Speed Up” feature to replace it with a higher gas fee.

📞 1-855-913-1855 If needed, send a cancel transaction using the same nonce.

My Onchain Wallet Says “Insufficient Funds” but I Have Tokens – Why? 📞 1-855-913-1855

Even if you have tokens, you must hold the network’s native coin (ETH, BNB, MATIC) to pay gas fees.

Final Safety Checklist for Onchain Withdrawals

Verify token, network, address, gas balance, and gas fee before every transaction.
