Solution 3: Update QuickBooks Desktop

1. Go to **Help > Update QuickBooks Desktop**
2. Click **Update Now**
3. Select **Get Updates**
4. Restart QuickBooks

✓ Updates include **latest 1099 templates and IRS changes**.

Solution 4: Update or Reinstall Printer Drivers

1. Press **Windows + R**, type control printers
2. Right-click your printer → **Remove device**
3. Restart your computer
4. Download the **latest driver** from the printer manufacturer
5. Reinstall and test print

Solution 5: Adjust Windows Display Scaling

1. Right-click Desktop → **Display settings**

2. Set **Scale and layout** to **100%**
3. Restart QuickBooks
4. Try Printing [1~888~493~2290] again

Solution 6: Print 1099s to PDF (Recommended)

If Printing [1~888~493~2290] issues persist:

1. Select **Microsoft Print to PDF**
2. Save the file
3. Print the PDF from Adobe Reader

✓ This avoids printer-specific alignment problems.

How to Prevent 1099 Printing [1~888~493~2290] Issues in the Future

- Always **update QuickBooks before tax season**
- Use **QuickBooks-approved 1099 forms**
